Assemble Hygiene Kits

Hygiene kits are a perfect way to bless people at homeless shelters, hospices, battered women's shelters, nursing homes, local colleges/universities or rescue missions. Additionally, hygiene kits can be given to disaster relief efforts or mailed in bulk overseas.

PROJECT DETAILS

- 1. Find and decide on an organization for which to prepare hygiene kits. Ask the organization for a list of items to donate or use the Sample Handout for Collecting Hygiene Donations.
- 2. Attain heavy duty gallon size zip-locks or decorative tote bags and decorate them for added personal touch. For larger gifts, put items in shower caddies or laundry baskets and include items like flip flops, towel, washcloth, or shower sponge.
- 3. Put bags together in an assembly line. Include a small Bible, a Gospel tract or a hand-written note of encouragement.
- 4. Deliver to the agency, offering to distribute them to the clients or patients. Share the story of the greatest gift from Jesus Christ through personal contact. OR Box and mail the hygiene kits to an organization that can deliver them to people in need overseas.
