

Guidelines *for use of the*

BPT Trailer

Who can use it?

The trailer is to assist member churches of Tri-County Baptist Association for the purpose of evangelism. Individuals are not eligible to use the trailer.

What is the cost?

\$50 non-refundable "wear and tear" fee
\$200 refundable deposit fee.

At the completion of your activity, simply return the trailer in operable and clean condition and submit the "Block Party Highlights" form. Once we have received the trailer in clean and operable condition and the Highlights form, we will return the deposit check.

Note: If your church has a plan for an evangelistic community event but is unable to provide the non-refundable "wear and tear" fee, please submit a Ministry Grant Request from the Tri-County website with your application.

How do I reserve it?

- Check the calendar at www.tcsba.com to see if dates are available.
- Fill out the Online Block Party Request form located on the website or print and email to meleta@tcsba.com or fax to (417) 725-8835.
- Wait for confirmation by telephone or email.
- Once confirmation is received, check calendar to verify dates are locked in.
- Pick up BPT no earlier than 24 hours in advance of the reservation date.
- A trained member will need to supervise the removal of items from the trailer and returning the items to the trailer.
- Review manual for instructions.
- After usage, retrieve the Block Party Check-In form and Highlights form, fill out and email to meleta@tcsba.com. Return the BPT to TCBA within 24 hours of the reservation date.
