2021 TCBA SUMMER CAMP UPDATE REVISED COVID-19 GUIDELINES

SUBJECT TO CHANGE

All campers will need to complete the **Lice/Covid-19 Health Screening Form included in this document**. Anyone with symptoms in the **24 hours** prior to arriving at Baptist Hill should stay home and not come to camp.

As part of our response to COVID-19, we ask all our campers to help us stop the spread by implementing the following:

TEMPERATURE CHECKS:

- Every camper should have their temperature taken the first day of camp, before coming to camp.
- To aid in stopping the spread during camp, anyone with a temperature of greater than 100.4 F will be sent home.

FACE COVERINGS:

- Masks/face coverings are welcome but not required when participating in indoor or outdoor activities.

HAND SANITIZER:

- Hand sanitizer will be provided for each camper for their personal use. Extra hand washing and hand sanitizing will be available and recommended often.

SOCIAL DISTANCING:

- Worship and classrooms will be set up to provide social distancing. Cabin capacity will be reduced to permit social distancing as well.

PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS:

- Individuals with preexisting conditions such as high blood pressure, diabetes, autoimmune disease, cardiovascular disease, respiratory disease (including asthma) and/or immunosuppressed are at an increased risk of severe illness or death if COVID-19 is contracted. These individuals may choose to not attend camp.

Children should be checked Wednesday, June 2 and rechecked on Sunday, June 6 prior to leaving for camp.
